Meet at Bank Farm Road Co-op, Radbrook, at 8.00am for car sharing; or direct to the Ogwen Valley at 10.00am, for a 10.15am start.

Specifically, meet at the inset car park on the south side of the road halfway along the lake.

Remember, the A5 is currently closed but the Coast Road route goes in two hours, just. If winter conditions are likely, bring an axe and crampons, as well as warm clothing.

Decision on routes on the day, but if snow is good, the Cwm Lloer headwall could make a good start to a tour of the southern Carneddau, alternatively, if there is no snow, the N ridge of Tryfan could be a good starter. Any queries, ring me on number below.
